Dear Student:

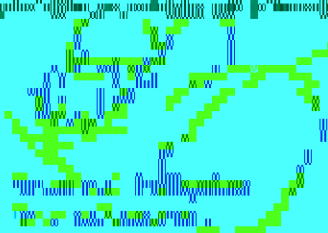
As you are aware, the Accrediting Institute of America (RIA A) is a non-academic organization that has been established to provide accreditation for certain educational institutions. RIA A is not a government agency and its accreditation is not recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or any other federal agency.

RIA A's accreditation is based on a set of standards that are not consistent with the standards of the U.S. Department of Education. Therefore, RIA A's accreditation does not guarantee that the educational institution it accredits meets the standards of the U.S. Department of Education.

Students should be aware that RIA A's accreditation is not a guarantee of quality. Students should always check the accreditation status of an educational institution and should only enroll in an institution that is accredited by the U.S. Department of Education or another recognized accrediting agency.
